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SPORTS POLICY~ 2023

The *Sports Section, Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur*, felt the need to evolve a Sports Policy which provides guidelines for effective functioning of the Department to achieve the desired goals.

The following rules have been framed for the organization and management of Sports & Games affairs in this University. These rules shall **supersede** all previous rules and regulations on the subject.

However, the Honb'le Vice Chancellor is authorized to make such rules as may be necessary, from time to time.

1. OBJECTIVES:

- i) To promote students' sports participation and to create awareness about the benefits of Physical Education & Sports and to spread Sports Culture among students.
- ii) To search Sports Talent at the College level and to groom them as better performers.
- iii) To Project the Potentials of University by organizing National Level Tournaments/Championships.
- **iv)** To provide Incentives and bestow Awards to Sportspersons to maintain sustained interest among students to participate and perform progressively.
- **v)** To involve Alumni, N.R.I's & other Sports Agencies for raising funds for the Development of Sports Infrastructure.
- vi) To initiate measures to evolve Group/Individual Accident Insurance Scheme for Sportspersons taking part in the Inter-University Competitions.
- vii) To Develop Adequate and Standard Sports Infrastructure Facilities like Playing Fields, Gymnasium, Swimming Pool, Track & Field, and procure Quality Equipment.
- viii) To provide Systematic Coaching Programme by involving Qualified & Competent Personnel to groom University Teams & Sports Talent.

2. CONSTITUTION OF UNIVERSITY SPORTS COMMITTEE:

There shall be a constituted body in the University called 'Sports Council'.

2.1) The following shall be the objects of the Sports Council, namely:

- i) To foster and encourage sports and sportsmanship amongst the students of the University;
- ii) To organize, control, manage and supervise Inter-Collegiate Sports and Games Tournaments/Championships within the jurisdiction of the University;
- iii) To regulate their conduct; and
- iv) To undertake and conduct Interuniversity Competitions.

2.2) Governing Body of the Sports Council shall consist of the following namely:

- i) The Vice Chancellor, Ex-Officio Chairman,
- ii) Pro-Vice Chancellor, Ex-Officio Co- chairman,

- iii) Registrar, Ex-Officio Member,
- iv) Finance Officer Treasurer, Member,
- v) Director, CDC Ex-Officio, Member,
- vi) Dean, Student Welfare Ex-Officio, Member,
- vii) Regional Higher Education Officer, Ex-Officio-Member,
- viii) Regional Sports Officer Ex-Officio, Member,
- ix) Two, Principals to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor-Members,
- **x)** Eight, Physical Education Teachers to be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor on the basis of area, one of whom shall be two female Physical Education Teacher, -Member,
- **xi)** Six, experts from the Physical Education & Sports as Special Invitees to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor every year, -Members,
- xii) Head, Physical Education, CSJMU Campus (Ex-Officio), -Members,
- xiii) Secretary, Sports Council, Ex-Officio, Member Secretary,
- xiv) Two, Joint Secretary Members,
- **xv)** Two, Outstanding Sports Person/Sports Organizers/AIU Medalist, -Members,
- xvi) Two, Student member from Students Council, ~Members.

Note:~

- a) The Secretary, Sports Council, shall act as the Convener of the Governing body of Sports Council.
- b) The members of the Council shall hold office for one year.
- c) The tenure of the Council will be of 01 years, which can be extended/modified/reconstituted as per the requirement of the Council.

2.3) The following shall be the responsibilities, powers and functions of the Sports Council, namely:

- i) to formulate Sports Policies, frame Rules & Regulations of Physical Education & Sports Programme from time to time.
- ii) to approve the budget of the council; for Promotion of Sports Activities.
- iii) to appoint Sub Committees to look after day today affairs of the Games & Sports Activities and Development Programmes.
- **iv)** to frame the Guidelines for Admission of Students under "Sports Quota" in the University and Affiliated Colleges.
- **v)** to frame the guidelines for awarding sports scholarships to outstanding sportspersons of university.
- vi) to revise the entry fee for utilization of various sports facilities (such as stadium, gymnasium hall, swimming pool, multipurpose hall and other sports grounds) from time- to- time.
- vii) to revise the proposals of Cash Award for Inter-University/AIU Medalists, Cash Prize for Inter-Collegiate Team Championship Winners, Mr. and Mrs. CSJMU Title Winner and Creators of New Record in Athletics and Cross Country Races.

- viii) to approve the names of suitable Physical Education and Coaching Professionals to serve on Various Selection Committees for Selecting Sportspersons for University Teams. The Secretary, Sports-Council will propose the names of Experts to be included in the Selection Committees and the same is placed before the University Sports Committee for its Assent.
- **ix)** The Sports Council shall lay down general policies for the conduct of sports and shall exercise general supervision over the sports affairs.
- **x)** Generally to take such steps as may be found necessary for the due discharge of the objectives of the Sports Council.

2.4) Meeting of the University Sports Council and Tenure of Members of Sports Council:

- i) The Sports Committee shall ordinarily meet Thrice in a Year, during the months of July/August, November/December & March/April. The Quorum for an Ordinary Meeting shall be 40% of the Members. For an Ordinary Meeting Ten days' notice with agenda shall be given.
- ii) Whenever there is any Valid Reason, an Extraordinary Meeting of the Sports Committee may be convened by the Member-Secretary with Seven days' notice. The Quorum for an Extraordinary Meeting shall be Five Members.
- iii) The Sports Council shall meet as often as may be considered necessary according to the circumstances.
- **iv)** The Principals of the Colleges and the members appointed by the Executive Council to the Sports Council shall ordinarily be persons possessing expert knowledge or experience in some branch of sports, and shall hold office for two years, but shall be eligible for re-appointment.
- v) The Physical Education Teachers and the students appointed by the Executive Council to the Sports Council shall hold office for one year only but shall be eligible for reappointment.
- vi) In the absence of the Chairman, the senior most member of the Sports Council shall preside over the meeting of the Sports Council.
- vii) All decisions shall be taken by a majority of votes of the members present. If votes, including that of the Chairman are equally divided, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- viii) Without prejudice to the provisions of 2.5 an annual meeting of the Sports Council shall be held in the Last week of March/April every year to consider the Sports Budget Estimates to be presented to the appropriate authorities of the University for Approval.
- **2.5)** The Council may delegate to the Committees appointed by it, such powers as may be necessary for the Committees in the discharge of the duties imposed on them by the council.

a) Sub-committee: The following shall be the constitution, powers and functions of the Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee of Sports Council shall consist of the following namely:

- i) Dean Student Welfare, Sports Council, Chairman.
- ii) Principal/Head/Director/Physical Education and Sports, act as Organizing Secretary of Tournament.
- iii) One Physical Education Teacher/Officer of CSJMU University, and Two members from among the Governing Body to be nominated by the Secretary, Sports Council, One of whom shall be a lady.
- iv) Secretary of the Council, Member Secretary.

The Sub Committee shall meet twice every year or whenever necessary on such days as may be fixed by the Chairman. Five members shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Sub-Committee.

The Committee shall have powers.

- i) To decide the venue of Inter college Tournament.
- ii) To decide the names of selectors, observers, for the Inter College Tournaments.
- iii) To recommend the names of members of Governing Body for the coming session for the approval of the Vice- Chancellor.
- **iv)** To prepare and recommend the Budget for the Organization of tournament to the General Body of the Council;
- **v)** To appoint the technical committee.
- vi) To consider the reports of the Organizing Secretaries and Observers of inter college tournaments and Managers/Coaches of the University Teams and such other reports received by the council from time to time.
- vii) To do all other things as may be necessary for the efficient conduct of the Inter College tournaments.
- **b)** Technical Committee: The following shall be the constitution, powers and functions of the Technical Committee.

The Technical Committee of Sports Council shall consist of the following namely:

- i) Head, Department of Physical Education CSJMU (Campus), Chairman.
- ii) Two members, having Specific knowledge of Concern Sports and Games to be nominated by the Secretary, Sports Council.
- iii) One Physical Education Teacher/Officer of CSJMU University, and Two members from among the Governing Body to be nominated by the Secretary, Sports Council, One of whom shall be a lady.
- iv) Joint Secretary of the Council, Member Secretary.

The technical Committee shall meet at least twice every year or whenever necessary on such days as may be fixed by the Chairman. 3 members shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Council.

The Committee shall have powers.

- i) To decide the dates of Inter College Competitions.
- ii) To prepare the fixtures for inter college Tournaments.
- iii) To verify the infrastructure & ground facilities of the venue for inter college tournaments.
- iv) To frame the rules and regulation for conduct of inter College tournaments.
- v) To decide all the technical matters related to conduct of intercollegiate tournaments, coaching camps, and inter university tournaments.
- **vi)** To settle dispute if any, between participating colleges with regard to tournaments / selection and other sports related activities within the jurisdiction of the sports council.

3. SECRETARY

The Secretary of Sports Council will be appointed/nominated by the Vice – Chancellor amongst the teachers of Physical Education and Sports of University Campus or /Affiliated Colleges/ Constituent Colleges.

The Secretary will be appointed/nominated for Minimum Period of a Year, which can be extended/modified/reconstituted as per the performance/requirement of the Council further one more year.

The secretary may be eligible for re-appointment/nominated after 5 year tenure in his/her service period.

3.1) Function of the Secretary, Sports Council

Subject to the provisions of these rules and the general instructions issued by the Sports Council, the Secretary shall perform the following functions:

- i) Shall organize Sports and Games Tournaments/Championships within the University and to prepare the annual sports programme for the approval of the Sports Council.
- ii) Shall send the Sports and Games teams to take part in the Intercollegiate/Intervarsity/All India University and other Tournaments/Championships and matches.
- iii) Shall promote generally the cause of sports and inculcate qualities of sportsmanship amongst students.
- **iv)** Shall nominate Convener and Organizing Secretary of various games of the University with the concurrence of the Chairman, Sports Council.
- v) Shall prepare the annual budget for the consideration of the Sports Council.
- vi) Shall maintain accounts and stores in accordance with the rules and instructions issued by the University.
- vii) Shall supervise and maintain the University play grounds, courts and other sports facilities.
- **viii)** Shall maintain a record of the members of University teams and their performances and achievements.

ix) The Secretary may permit a playground, court or any other sports facility to be used by Sports Clubs, Associations, teams or individuals not connected with the University for the purposes of non-University Tournaments/Championships, matches and other sports events on payment (determined by Sports Council from time to time) with such terms and conditions as the Secretary of Sports may impose after the approval of the Sports Council.

3.2) Administrative & Financial Duties of the Secretary

a) Administrative

The Secretary of the Sports council shall carry on routine correspondence on behalf of the Sports council and give effect to the resolutions of the same as its Executive Officer. He shall issue notice of meetings and record minutes of the same and shall be responsible for their maintenance. He shall also be responsible for the maintenance of other records or registers as well as the custody of any or all property of the Sports Council.

b) Financial:

He shall receipts the fund in the form of *Advance Imprest Money* from the university by giving requisition from time to time to meet the day to day expenses. Payments shall be made by him in accordance with the rules of the Sports Council and he shall maintain accounts of the amount received and expenditure incurred for the same to the University. He shall receive the budget provision grants from the University and keep the detailed account of expenditure duly supported by vouchers for Audit. He shall be solely responsible for the cash, stores and accounts of the Sports council. He will act as per the decision of the Finance Committee (FC). One separate S/B Account may be opened in the names of Secretary, Sports Council and to be operated by the Secretary. All money received from the F.C. on the basis of requisition given by the Secretary, Shall have to be deposited in that account and to be spent for meeting day to day expenditures of the Sports Council as per the budget of the Sports Council.

4. BUSINESS TO BE CONDUCTED AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SPORTS COMMITTEE:

- i) Perusal & Approval of Annual Budget Estimates of the Sports Section.
- ii) Perusal & Approval of Panel of Committee Members for Selection of Student Sportspersons for Inter-University Competitions.
- iii) Perusal & Approval of the Budget Estimate for Felicitation Function of All India Inter-University Tournaments/Championships Medalists, Incentives for Inter-Collegiate Champions and Others.
- **iv)** To plan the Organization of any Inter-University Tournaments/Championships allotted by the A.I.U.
- **v)** To discuss & ratify the proposals made at the Annual Representatives Meeting of the University & Affiliated Colleges.

vi) Any other matter pertaining to the Sports Activities may be taken up for discussion & decision with the permission of the Chair.

5. SPORTS FEES

Sports fees as decided by the Executive Council of CSJM University, Kanpur will be collected from the student taking admission /re-admission in degree streams of affiliated colleges of the University.

Besides that the colleges desirous of participating any Intercollegiate Tournaments/Championships shall have to pay registration fee as decided by the Sports Council from time to time.

All the sports fees and registration fees shall be paid via Online in favor of Finance Officer, CSJM University, Kanpur.

College/ Institution will have to spend the college share money collected from the students for deputing teams for Intercollegiate Tournaments/Championships organized by the Sports Council in that year only. An Utilization certificate to that extent shall have to be submitted by the Principal of the concerned college that all amount collected as college share has been fully utilized (in requisite proforma). Otherwise the unspent balance if any shall have to be refunded to the University with immediate effect before getting the clearance from the Sports Council to make the college eligible to submit the examination form as per the Executive Council decision. The amount of sports fees may be changed from time to time as a when required with due approval of Executive Council.

All the amount received from the Colleges/ Institutes will be deposited in a separate account with due custody of the Finance Officer and it will be spent only for sports activities and sports development works of the Sports Council, CSJM University accordingly approved budget duly passed by the Finance Committee.

In no case the Sports Fee which is student money, shall be diverted for any other purpose by the University.

6. SPORTS & GAMES ACTIVITIES

- **6.2)** Equipment needed for various games and sports shall be purchased in accordance with the University Purchase Rules.
- **6.3)** For the purposes of the University Sports Tournaments/Championships, the Sports Council may modify any of the above rules with due permission of Chairman.

7. REMUNERATION, TRAVELLING AND OTHER ALLOWANCES

- i) Travelling Allowances of the members of the Sports Council and Committees for attending meeting called by the Sports Council for transaction of business connected with the University will be paid as per the University norms from the Council fund.
- ii) Remuneration and other allowances of the Official, Players, Managers, Observer, Selector and Coaches of university teams proceeding for Intercollegiate and

Interuniversity tournaments will be paid as per the decision of the Governing Body from year to year from Council fund.

8. SCALE OF EXPENSES

- i) A University sportsman participating in an organized tournament outside the University Campus within the jurisdiction of CSJMU, Kanpur shall be paid the actual charges spent on transportation as certified by the Coach/Managers.
- ii) A sportsman participating in an organized tournament outside in different regions of India as a representative of the University shall be paid:
 - a) Sleeper/Third Class/Second Class Railway/Bus/ Air fare where the journey or part of the journey is performed by Train/Bus/Air to and from the place where the tournament is held and other incidental traveling expenses such as cooli charges, tanga and taxi fare; and
 - b) Allowance during the period of his journey to and from the place where the tournament is held and during his stay there; Unless he is paid by the authority sponsoring such tournament as per University Norms as decided by FC and EC time to time.
- iii) Where the traveling and food expenses received by a sportsman from the authorities sponsoring the tournament fall short of the charges admissible under the preceding rule he shall be paid the difference from the Sport Fund.
- **iv)** The Secretary may permit an attendant to accompany a team. Such an attendant shall be entitled to draw traveling allowances in accordance with the University traveling Allowance Rules.
- v) All Notification regarding attendance of the players in the various games shall be issued by the Secretary.
- vi) Accommodation for sportsmen participating in tournaments outside city should be arranged for wherever possible, in University, College and University Sports Hostels or Guest Houses. If it is at all necessary to stay in a hostel the prior permission of the Chairman, Sports Council shall be obtained and he may fix the lodging charge.
- vii) In University sports tournaments, contestants in team /individual events securing the first three places shall be awarded Cash and/or Trophies Prizes (plus certificates) and decided by Sports Council time to time.
- **viii)** In the case of sportsmen representing the University in the Intervarsity Zonal / National Championship, refreshment charges shall be allowed as per University Norms as decided by Sports Council passes by FC and EC time to time.
- **ix)** Training and coaching camp may, with the prior approval of the Chairman of the Sports Council, be organized for a game before the Intervarsity championships but the duration of the camp shall not exceed six weeks. Diet money will be decided by Sports Council passes by FC and EC time to time.

- **x)** If a sportsman of the University is selected as a member of a National Team or for participation in a National / Indian Universities team to play outside India, he may be given an outfit allowance will be provided as per University Norms.
- **xi)** Articles required for First Aid Box may be purchased collectively and adequate issued to a team as and when required.
- **xii)** A player injured in a practice or regular match, organized at the University grounds or in a recognized match outside the University may on the recommendation of the University Medical officer, or other Medical Authority, if the Injury occurs outside city, be treated in a recognized hospital or referred to a recognized Medical Specialist for treatment.
- xiii) Medical charges incurred in this connection will be reimbursed from the Sports fund on production of actual payment receipts verified by the University Medical Officers as representing legitimate Medical charges. If unutilized or part thereof, shall be reappropriated in some other heads of the Sport Council Budget.
- **xiv)** The Chairman, Sports Council, may sanction special expenditure entertainment in connection with special sports events e.g. IYD, National Sports Day etc.
- **xv)** Each sportsman selected as a member of a University team is entitled to get track suit and a free kit according to game point of view.
 - a) For Athlete/Sportsmen (Men & Women)
 - b) Managers & Asstt. Manager/ Coach(es)
 - c) Officials (Men & Women) During National & Other Championships

9. UNIVERSITY COLOUR

- i) The University Colour means the insignia of the University with the name of the particular game worn on a coat pocket.
- ii) The following shall be entitled to wear the University colour:
 - **a)** A person winning the first place in an individual event in a National or Intervarsity Championship.
 - b) A person selected as a member of a National team or an Indian Universities team.
 - c) A person played at least 3 years Interuniversity Championship and scored position upto Bronze Medal (IIIrd Position).
- iii) A person who had been awarded colour in a game shall not be eligible for the second colour in the same game in any subsequent year.
- iv) No person shall be eligible for the award of colour if in the opinion of the Sports Council, his conduct has not been consistently good and/or issued a warning letter/show cause notice in written from the Secretary, Sports Council.
- **v)** A person awarded the University colour shall be granted a certificate of authority to wear it.

- vi) The colour may be withdrawn by the Sports Council if the holder is found guilty of misconduct or indiscipline.
- vii) The Vice-Chancellor may set aside or alter any decision of the Sports Council in emergency situation.

10. INTERCOLLEGIATE/ INTERUNIVERSITY TOURNAMENTS

Intercollegiate/ Interuniversity Tournaments may be conducted in accordance of AIU, Rules and Regulations as amended time to time. [Annexure 01 (A & B)]

11. SPORTS QUOTA ADMISSION

11.1) Selection of Players - University will grant admission to talented players against sports quota (to be fixed from time to time) on the basis of trials. **(Annexure 02)**

Note: All the players who get admission in sports quota shall have given undertaking at the time of admission to Secretary, Sports Council, in which they have to mention that they will take part in the inter-university/National tournaments. Any student found not serious in the practice and if they do not participate in the inter-university tournaments, University has right to cancel their concession and they shall have to pay full fee as normal students.

11.2) Attendance of the players ~ Attendance of the players from the regular academic classes will be based on the recommendation of the Director/Deputy Director/Assistant Director of Physical Education. The leave taken for practice, competition and coaching camp will be considered as present.

12. FINANCIAL AND OTHER ASSISTANCE

12.1) T.A, D.A. for participating Inter-University/All India competitions

All the players and officials participating in Interuniversity competition will be provided the T.A, D.A, as per following norms:

12.2) Uniform- University will provide the uniform to the player, coaches, and other supporting staff. The maximum cost of the uniform should be of Rs.2000/-only.

- **12.3)** Coaching Camp: The department will conduct the coaching camp for the selected players to participate in Inter-University competition for minimum 15 days (Prior to the conduct of Inter-university competition). During coaching camp all the selected players and team officials will be provided the diet @ Rs. 200/ per day, T.A & D.A. as per University Norms.
- **12.4) Appointment of the Coaches** For the specific training of the teams or players (Wherever required), university will provide the qualified coaches to the players. Coaches will be appointed on contract basis up to inter-university tournaments. For the special training during coaching camp department can hire coach on daily basis @ Rs.1000 per day.
- **12.5) Equipment** Sports Department will issue the equipment's to the players for practice (Wherever required).
 - i) The consumable items issued to players will be written off from the department stock register immediately and it will not be taken back.
 - ii) Non- consumable items shall be returned to the department store by the players in the same working condition.
 - iii) Other than the Intervarsity participation, Individual sports equipment's will not be issued to any student
- **12.6) Sports infrastructure~** Higher sports performance requires specific infrastructure as per requirement of the game. The University will maintain the infrastructure and develop it according to the need of players and competition.
- **12.7) Award and incentive-** To motivate the position holders the University will reward the players at the end of the session as per following norms:
 - i. Best sports person male and female (One trophy and Rs. 10000 cash).
 - ii. Cash prizes will be given to the position holders, Players of the team/individual events as mentioned below.
 - iii. Along with the Cash prizes Public Honor and Letter of Appreciation will also be provided.

12.8) CONDUCT OF SPECIAL/SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMS FOR PURSUING THEIR TALENT OUTSIDE ACADEMICS

Students participating in Intercollegiate, Interuniversity, State, National and International level Sports & Games Tournaments/Championships will be able to appear separately for their semester exams, if they clashes with or close to the dates of Competition/ Tournaments.

Note: Working Hours may be modified by the Secretary/Director/Deputy Director/Assistant Director suiting the needs of Students & Weather conditions.

15. MODIFICATION/CHANGE OF BYE-LAW

Any minor Change if so arises in due course of time of implementation of the Rule and if the Governing Body recommends such minor changes to be included/modified/deleted in the Bye-Law, then Chairman, Sports Council is empowered to incorporate such changes in the Rule. The Bye-Law will be effective from the session 2023-24 onwards.

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#### 1. INTERCOLLEGIATE TOURNAMENTS

- i) General Rules pertaining to the organization of Intercollegiate Competitions and Selection Trials
  - a) The Sports Council of CSJM University shall have the power to include or exclude any of the Intercollegiate competitions of the sports & games listed in AIU with due approval from the Governing Board of the Council. The Date and Venue of the Intercollegiate Tournaments shall be fixed by the technical committee and approved by the Secretary every year.
  - b) All affiliated colleges will send their entry to participate in the Intercollegiate Tournaments directly to the Secretary, Sports Council of CSJM University in the prescribed proforma along with entry fees which will be decided by the Sports Council and realized and used by the Organizing Committee for each game separately.
  - c) Each potential college shall take the responsibility in consultation with the Secretary, Sports Council to organize one major/minor tournaments which may be taken on the rotary basis.
  - d) According to the numbers of entry received by the Sports Council in each game, the technical committee of the sports council will decide whether the Intercollegiate Tournament will be held on single, two or more zone basis as well as the nature of the fixture drawn for the same.
  - e) Interested affiliated colleges, having adequate facilities and infrastructure will send their willingness in the prescribed proforma to host Intercollegiate Tournaments in their college in the month of July every year.
  - f) The venue of the Intercollegiate Tournaments will be decided by the Subcommittee considering the following points. (A) Area wise evenly spread location (B) Communication to venue (C) Infrastructure. (D) Competency of the organizing college. (E) Accommodation and Food facility.
  - g) The dates of the intercollegiate competition will be decided by the technical committee as per the Dates available and approved by the AIU for All India and Zonal Level Interuniversity Tournaments.
  - h) Competition calendar for the Inter-University and Intercollegiate Tournaments will be made available on the University website and will be circulated to all affiliated colleges for the student's information. All the affiliated colleges have to keep it on the college notice board till the last date of the intercollegiate competition.
  - i) Financial assistance for the conduct of the Intercollegiate Tournaments will be provided to the hosting colleges by the Sports Council as per the budget approved by the Working Committee of the Sports Council.

- ii) Every college desirous of conducting an Intercollegiate Tournament on behalf of the Sports Council shall be responsible for the smooth conduct of the Intercollegiate Tournament, For this purpose the Principal of the organizing college shall appoint a competent body to be known as the Organizing Committee.
- iii) The Principal or his nominee will be the organizing Secretary of the Organizing Committee and Physical Education Teacher of the college will act as the coordinator of the committee.
- iv) All the Intercollegiate Tournaments must be organized by the qualified workforce by the host college and the entire tournaments must be refereed /umpired / Judged by qualified technical officials of the particular sports and games.
- v) The Organizing Secretary shall be empowered to select/appoint the competent referee/ official for the tournament as qualified Umpire/Referee as per requirement, Qualified Umpire-cum-Selector 01, Class III Staff 01 and Class IV staff/grounds man 02.
- vi) Only the students fulfilling the eligibility rules of A.I.U will be allowed to participate in the Intercollegiate Tournaments. A student shall not be allowed to represent on behalf of more than one college in any Inter Collegiate Tournaments in a year.
- vii) The participating colleges shall submit the eligibility list of the players as per the proforma sent by the Secretary, Sports Council along with the Identity Cards, photo graphs and Xerox copies of the H.S.C / +2 Certificates duly attested by the Principal to the organizing college before the commencement of the tournament.
- viii) The organizing college will properly verify the authenticity of the players participating in the tournament through
  - a) Verification of the Fee Slips/identity card.
  - b) Verification of eligibility proforma, age proof as per AIU
  - c) Verification of H.S.C. / +2 Original Certificates.
  - d) Verification of photo graphs and Xerox copies of the H.S.C / +2 Certificates duly attested by the Principal
- ix) The organizing College shall provide free, neat and clean lodging facilities (Dari, Bucket, Mug, etc.), adequately equipped with toilet, drinking water and light etc. to the participating colleges. The lodging arrangements shall be near the ground/court as far as possible and in no case the same should be more than 1KM away from the playing area. The grounds, courts, etc and the equipments used for the inter-College Tournaments must conform to national specifications.
- X) It shall be the duty of the organizing committee to ensure that all the rules and regulations laid down by the sports council for the Inter Collegiate tournaments are fully observed and the Game/Tournament is played fairly. In case, a particular team has included ineligible player, as defined in the rules, the team shall be disqualified from the tournament after due verification. In case of the misconduct

by any individual player(s) or a team as a whole, the organizing committee shall have the power even to debar the team/disqualify the individual player(s) from the tournament. While doing so, however, the organizing committee shall strictly follow the procedure as laid down below:

- a) Both the teams under dispute are given full opportunities to explain their respective points of view.
- b) The Principal of the organizing college shall constitute a technical committee consisting of
  - (i) Organizing Secretary
  - (ii) Coordinator (Physical Education Teacher),
  - (iii) Two expert of the concerned game.
  - (iv) Observers (Member, from the Council)
- c) The matter shall have to be is reported immediately to the Secretary, Sports Council for information and further action if any.
- xi) Protest against the decision of referee or umpire or any other matter shall be lodged in writing within two hours of conclusion of the game and depositing Rs.2000/-with the Organizing Secretary of the tournament . If the protest is lodged during the match, the match shall be played out. Any team, leaving field of play under protest, shall be deemed to have lost the match and forfeited its right to protest. The decision of technical committee in this regard is final. The protest fee shall be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. Organizing Secretary shall send a report to the Secretary, Sports Council.
- **xii)** A minimum of five teams for Men and four teams for Women are essential to organize the tournament otherwise the tournament will be automatically treated as cancelled.
- **xiii)** The affiliated college must send their students with proper uniforms to take part in intercollegiate tournaments. The students are not allowed to take part in any of the Intercollegiate Tournaments in civil dress.
- **xiv)** No affiliated colleges are allowed to take part in any intercollegiate competitions in which they are participating or any sports and games without a qualified physical educator.
- XV) The rules and regulations of the sports and games will be strictly followed as is framed by the concerned Association/Federation of the sports and games at National level.
- xvi) The selection of the university team shall be made on the basis of performance in the Intercollegiate Tournaments. The selection committee for the final team selection comprises of Principal/Organizing Secretary (Chairman), and the Selector (S), Observer(s) to be deputed by the University. The Secretary, reserves the right to cancel or change the selection list if required.

- **xvii)** It shall be the duty of the Organizing Secretary to inform the Secretary, Sports Council regarding the tournament and submit the copy of eligibility proforma and result of the tournament and the list of the selected team of the university with one week from the date of completion of tournament.
- **xviii)** The Organizing Secretary of intercollegiate tournaments must submit the detailed report of the competition and the vouchers supporting expenditures made during the competition within 15 days to the Principal. Utilization Certificated of the Expenditure duly signed by Principle of the College must be submitted to the Secretary, Sports Council, C.S.J.M., University for audit purpose, failing which further tournaments may not be given to conduct defaulter affiliated college.

#### 1.1) Conduct of the Draw (Fixture):

All the Intercollegiate Tournaments will be played on knock out basis. The Intercollegiate Tournaments where the number of participating teams will be more than 15 teams the draw (fixture) shall be made by the Sports Council and in case of less team participation the fixture will be prepared on the spot by the organizing college in presence of all the managers of participating teams and the observer of the tournament. The technical committee of the Sports council will take the final decision in this matter.

#### 1.2) Trophies and Certificates:

- i) The Sports Council of CSJM University shall provide the trophies to winner and runners-up teams The College receiving running trophies shall hold themselves responsible for the safe custody of the trophies received. All the trophies of Inter-Collegiate Tournament shall be running (rolling) trophies.
- ii) There shall be one replica along with the certificates for each championship trophy given by the organizing secretary, the replica shall be retained permanently by the winning college and shall be the property of the wining college.
- iii) The college holding any of the rolling trophies shall return the same to the Secretary, Sports Council at its own cost in the month of June every year.
- iv) A certificate of merit signed by the Secretary, Sports Council shall be awarded to the individual member of the winner and Runners up team in team games, weight lifting and individual athletic championship and to individuals securing first and second places in athletics/Best physique for Intercollegiate Tournaments. All the players participating Interuniversity tournaments/All India tournaments/any national games are to be provided a certificate of merit signed by the Secretary and Vice-Chancellor of the University.
- **v)** Overall championship in Athletics shall be given in male and female categories separately.
- vi) Best performer College(s) and Best sports talent of the year may be honored with special medals for both men and women events. This has to be decided by the committee on the basis of performance during that period.

- vii) Best sport performance at zonal level of CSJMU, Kanpur shall be ear-marked for each year.
- viii) Sports Council with due approval of Chairman may provide sports equipment to any Affiliated Colleges on the basis of competency of players of that event to promote them for better interest of the University.

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2. INTERUNIVERSITY TOURNAMENTS

- i) The University may participate in the Inter-University tournaments /Competitions/ as may be decided by the sports council from time to time.
- ii) The Secretary, Sports Council may appoint any staff member, any expert in the field of that game as Team manager who will be overall responsible for the participation in the tournament in association with the Coach.
- iii) T.A, D.A and other remuneration as per Sports Council decision shall be paid to the Manager in advance. After completion of assignment, Manager has to submit the paid vouchers immediately to the Sports Council for the audit purpose within a fortnight and reconcile the same immediately.

2.1) Process of Selection of University Teams for Participation in the Inter- University Competitions:

- i) The Selection of Players/Teams for Various Inter-University Competitions will be done by the Committees formed by the University Sports Council.
- ii) Each Selection Committee which will be chaired by the Secretary, Sports Council & Department of Physical Education shall be Comprised of Four Members drawn out of Physical Education/Coaching Professionals/SAI /Coaches from Affiliated Sports Associations/other Personnel Proposed by the Council as the need arises.
- iii) Only Bonafide, Fulltime Students, who are Enrolled for a Course of the University, which is of a Minimum Duration of One Academic Year and where Examination is Conducted by the University and those who fulfill the Eligibility Criteria laid down by the A.I.U, New Delhi shall be Eligible to take part in the Selection Process.
- **iv)** To be Eligible to Represent University the Sportspersons shall fulfill the Minimum Physical Fitness Standards (Norms) Prescribed by the Sports Section, CSJMU, Kanpur. The Physical Fitness Norms will be revised from time-to-time.
- V) In Team Games the Selection Trials will be Conducted for the Players who Pass the "Physical Fitness Tests" Prescribed by the Sports Section from time-to -time. In case of Sportspersons who are Representing State, Participating in National Championships, International Championships, Attending National Level Camps and who are unable to attend or participate in the Selection Trials may be considered for selection to represent University at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
- vi) In Individual Events the Players who reach Qualifying Standard Fixed by A.I.U i.e. upto 10th Position Performance in the Previous Year's Interuniversity Competitions, will be considered for Selection to Represent University based on the Recommendation of the Selection Committee.
- vii) In Wrestling/ Best Physique/ Gymnastics/ Yogasana the Selection Committee

- Members will Finalize the University Teams based on the Performance at the University Inter-Collegiate Competitions. However Wrestlers & Gymnasts shall fulfill the Minimum Prescribed Physical Fitness Norms.
- viii) The Eligibility Particulars of the Players who are attending the University Team Selection Trials should be sent in Advance by the Institutions or Colleges to the Department of Physical Education Sports. The A.I.U. Eligibility Criteria will be followed.
- ix) The University Team's Captaincy will be decided by the Secretary, Sport-Council based on Seniority/Game Knowledge/Discipline/Leadership Qualities/ Participation in the National Championship/Achievements in the Inter-University Competitions and National Championships/ Class/Age. In Ordinary conditions, any player is entitled to captain a university team in a particular Game/Event only once in his/her career.
- The Selection Committee will select the Players and Stand-Bys of the University Teams based on their Performance during the Trials/ Competitions. If Performance Standard of any Team / Player is not Satisfactory as felt by the Selection Committee Members, on the Recommendations of the Committee such Team/Player may not be sent for Participation in Inter-University Tournaments. They will be invited for Coaching Camp by the Secretary, Sports Council on getting the Information from the Organizing University. The duration of Coaching/ Training Camp may vary depending upon Circumstances/ Conditions.
- Xi) Attending University Team Coaching is Compulsory and in case any Team Player(s) is/are Absent for Camp, Stand-By(s) will be called for the Camp by Secretary, Sports Council, However Sportsperson(s) who is/are Participating in the Inter-Collegiate, National or Inter- National Competitions during the University Team's Coaching Camp may be Exempted by the Secretary, Sports Council from Attending the Camp.
- Xii) If any University Player Misbehaves during the Coaching/ Inter-University Competitions, Disciplinary Action will be initiated by the Director/Deputy Director/Assistant Director of Physical Education, based on the Report Submitted by the Team Manager/Coach, by way of barring the player from participating in the University Inter-Collegiate Tournaments/Inter-University Tournaments for a period of one to three years depending on the gravity of misconduct.
- xiii) The TA/DA of University Team Players/Mangers/Coaches and other accompanying officials will be borne by the university as per the provisions made in the University Sports Committee from time- to- time. Money earmarked for various teams as per budget allocation will be advanced to the team manager & in turn they shall maintain proper accounts and submit the same at the office of the Secretary, Sports Council on Completion of Team's Engagement.
- **xiv)** The University Team Mangers/Coaches will be nominated by the Secretary, Sports Council based on their Experience/Knowledge/Ability/Proficiency.

- XV) The University Players/Officials will be provided with Track Suits/Sports Wears with University Logo as per the Colour Combination Proposed by the Sports Section. Team Official's Track Suits Colour Combination will be Different from that of the University Players.
- **xvi)** The University Players have to Produce Medical Certificate and give an Undertaking before going to Participate in the Inter-University Tournaments as per the format issued by the Sports Section Office.
- **xvii)** The University sportspersons participating in the Inter-University tournaments shall be covered by appropriate accident/medical insurance scheme.
- **xviii)** The Players who may get injured during the course of coaching camp, journey period or while participating in the Inter-University Tournaments will be governed by the conditions of the accident/medical insurance scheme. For medical expenses covering minor ailments which are not covered by accident/medical insurance scheme reimbursement of expenses shall be allowed on production of doctor's prescription & proper bills which are duly certified by the team manager.
- **xix)** The University teams will be fielded for participation in the inter-university competitions in the activities for men & women as previously mentioned in sub point (7.1) based on the recommendation of selection committees.
- XX) The players who have represented CSJMU in various activities and the accompanying officials of various teams may obtain representation certificate/participation certificate signed by the Secretary, Sport-Council after the completion of the inter-university tournaments/ competitions by submitting requisition letter and paying prescribed fee at the department office.
- **XXI)** The players may obtain attendance certificates for the period of attending coaching camp and inter-university tournaments for regularizing their attendance in their schools, as per the university norms.
- **xxii)** Officials accompanying the university teams for inter-university competitions will be issued attendance certificate on completion of assignment.

The university aims to spot such talent and nurture it by way of financial assistance for coaching, nutrition, equipment and participation.

- 1. RULES FOR ADMISSION AGAINST SEATS EARMARKED UNDER SPORTS QUOTA: On the basis of the performance at different levels of Sports and Games; as listed on point no. 6 of the policy to be considered for Scholarship.
- 2. Following are the details of the Scholarship provided on the basis of Performance in Sports; wherein Sports Championship/Tournaments/Completions are Organized under the aegis of:-

#### 3. PROCEDURE FOR MONTHLY DIET

- i) Monthly diet will be provided only for Six months (Minimum) to Eight months (maximum).
- ii) Monthly diet will be provided for those Games, which are valid for MAKA Trophy.

#### 4. SPECIAL CHANCE FOR POTENTIAL PLAYERS:

- i) Special case will only be provided to potential players of the games, In which, time, height and distance can be measured:
- ii) Special case will be recommended for team games by the Sports Selection Committee.
- iii) The team game should be considerable in MAKA Trophy; wherein:
  - a) Monthly Diet will not be provided in Special case.
  - b) Academic Fee Concession will be given for one year only.
  - c) Free Hostel and free food facility for one year.

Note: If student didn't win the medal in one year, minimum at AIIU/National level, he will pay the entire academic fee, Hostel Fee from next year.

### 5. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i) If a student (International Medalist) takes admission in other courses than B.A., B.P.Ed and P.G.Yoga, then concession will remain the same as 'A++' category.
- ii) If, Any Non-Scholarship Student got Medal in International / National / AIIU, he/she will be eligible for Sports Scholarship according to level of performance and category.
- iii) Only vacant seats will be filled in each game/every year.
- iv) Only last two-year performance Certificates will be considered.
- v) Academic Fee Concession includes Uniform fee, Examination fee, and all other fee For 'A++' and A+ Category.
- vi) Minimum 90% attendance is must for continuation of monthly diet.
- vii) Following Team games will be considered: Football, Cricket, Volleyball, Basketball, Tug of War, Kabaddi, Hockey, Tennis, Badminton, Table Tennis and Handball.
- viii) Preference will be given to the Individual games.

- ix) On the basis of performance/ achievements the concession is revised every year, as: Concession will be revised after one year according to level of performance/achievement.
- **x)** If any player will not get any position in International/ National/AIIU tournaments his/her Monthly Diet will be discontinued in Second year and if he/she did not get position in second year his/her Sports scholarship will also be withdrawn in 3rd year.
- **xi)** Concession will be increased or decreased according to performance/achievement at the time of renewal. Minimum North Zone Inter University medal will be considered for renewal of scholarship; state medal will not be considered.
- **xii)** If student takes general admission and he has achieved medal in North Zone/ All India Inter University/ National/ International, he will be provided the scholarship benefit in the next following year, according to the level of achievement as per category.
- xiii) Attendance will be provided to students, who will participate in North Zone/AIIU/National/International Competition from the date of departure to date of return at University.
- **xiv)** Training camp attendance of Players inside and outside campus will be taken regularly. Minimum camp attendance of each player should be 90%.
- **xv)** University has the right to change terms and conditions of the University Sports Policy anytime without any prior notice.

# 6. SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR SPORTS QUOTA ADMISSION WILL BE DONE BY THE SPORTS COMMITTEE:

- i) Performance Trials will be taken before admission.
- ii) Original certificates are required for verification.
- iii) Gradation will be required in doubtful cases.
- iv) Final decision for admission will be taken by Director Students Welfare.

#### 7. DISCONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP AND INCENTIVES:

- i) If Student is not fulfilling AIIU eligibilities.
- ii) If the student misbehaves with any faculty member/Staff/ Student.
- iii) If the student indulges in any indiscipline activity.
- iv) If the student doesn't participate in North Zone/All India Inter University due to any reason.
- v) If attendance will be lesser than 90% in the training camps (Inside and outside the campus).
- vi) If a player is found positive in doping test during any competition/trials.
- vii) If a player indulged in criminal activities, he/she can be terminated from the University.
